MOOMBA

History: Begun in 1955 to support the arts, the first festival was a fifteen-day event now four days. In 1959 to coincide with this event, and influx of tourists, the Victorian Philatelic Association decided to hold a stamp display, and applied to the Postmaster General for permission to print an aerogramme which reflected the festival theme. Permission was granted and Permit No. 21 was assigned to the Association. Licence is still current.

Designer: John Flexmore, of Melbourne, Victoria, Australia.

Printer: Sands and McDougall Pty. Ltd., Melbourne, Victoria, Australia on Azure sunlight paper Format III as Australian Aerogrammes ready for the 1960 festival. Numbers printed unknown.

Price: 6d each + postage + 6d service fee.






The guide included advertising, Philatelic Societies of Victoria, and details of the 23 exhibits on display. Available for sale at 6d each.

Permit 21 Aerogramme, light printing used on first day of the exhibition 2 MAR 62 (1962 added) postmark.








Although super-ceded by 1963 design the Tiger Cat aerogramme was used from later festivals.




