## TANK LOCOMOTIVES ON WELSH HERITAGE RAILWAYS

#### **HERITAGE RAILWAYS:**

Narrow gauge railways in Wales in the 19th century began carrying minerals from the coal and slate mines to the ports in Wales and in others, passengers. These tank locomotives now ferry tourists, on these heritage railways, into the heart of rural Wales.

A 'tank locomotive' or 'tank engine' is a steam locomotive that carries its water in one or more on-board water tanks, instead of a tender.

#### SCOPE:

Through stamps, covers, and railwayana show the story of the tank locomotives at the heritage and preserved railways in Wales, United Kingdom.

## Corris Heritage Railway. 0-4-0ST & 0-4-2ST

Opened in1859 Corris Heritage Railway is a narrow gauge railway based in Corris on the border between Merionethshire (now Gwynedd) and Montgomeryshire (now Powys) in Mid-Wales. In 1929, Imperial Tramways sold Corris to the GWR.

Passenger services ceased in 1931 but still carried freight until 1948 when it finally closed. Reopened in 2002 as a tourist attraction with new locos.

## Welsh Highland Railway (WHR) 0-4-2T & 0-4-0ST

WHR is a short reconstructed heritage railway in Gwynedd, Wales which ran from 1922-1936.

In the 1960s the original Welsh Highland Railway was reconstructed by Ffestiniog Railway Company and Welsh Highland Railway Ltd. and opened for passengers in 1980.

Main station is in Porthmadog.

First steam engine to haul a passenger train on the WHR. 'Karen' presently stored out of traffic - on display in the shed.






## Talyllyn Heritage Railway. 0-4-2ST & 0-4-0WT





## Talyllyn Heritage Railway. 0-4-2ST (ST- Saddle Tank)

Opened 1865 to carry slate from the quarries at Bryn Eglwys to Tywyn in Wales. Presently a narrow gauge preserved railway running for 12 klm from Tywyn on the Mid-Wales coast to Nant Gwernol near the village of Abergynolwyn.

Major tourist attraction located within Snowdonia National Park and runs from the harbour at Porthmadog to the slate mining town of Blaenau Ffestinog.

Railway has eleven operational steam locos.

## Welshpool & Llanfair Light Railway. 0-6-0T

Narrow gauge heritage railway in Powys, Wales opened in 1903 for freight and passsengers from Welshpool and Llanfair. In the 1923 grouping the railway absorbed by the GWR.


Both locos. delivered in 1902. Loco #1 became #822 'The Earl' and #2 #823 'The Countess' at 1923 GWR grouping.



## Welshpool & Llanfair Light Railway. 0-6-2T & 0-6-0T

In 1931 the line became a freight-only line until closure in 1956. In 1963 the western half of the line, from Llanfair Caereinion to Castle Caereinion, was reopened as a Heritage railway.

# Taff Vale Railway 150th Anniversary



Opened in stages from 1840. A standard gauge railway in South Wales, built by the Taff Vale Railway Company to serve the iron and coal industries around Merthyr Tydfil and to connect them with docks in Cardiff. Since 2020 the main routes of the railway are for passengers.

Loco #28 (0-6-2T) shown in stamp and cover remained in service until 1926 when renumbered for war use - WD 205. In 1927 sold to the National Coal Borad and eventually back to the Taff Vale Railway.








## Vale of Rheidol Heritage Light Railway 2-6-2T

In 1922, the railway was grouped into the GWR. A new station opened next to main standard gauge station in Aberystwyth.

The GWR Rheidol Tanks design built between 1923 and 1924 designed by the railway's Chief Mechanical Engineer Charles Collett.

Opened 1902 between Aberystwyth and Devil's Bridge to carry lead ore from Rheidol mines to port of Aberystwyth.




